

At Wind Haven Foundation, your privacy and safety are top priorities. To keep your participation in our Discord support group confidential and secure, please follow these important security practices:

1. Use a Non-Identifying Email

When signing up for Discord, use an email that doesn't contain your real name or identifying info. You can create a new one just for this.

2. Create an Anonymous Username

Choose a username that doesn't link to your identity. Feel free to use a name or phrase that keeps you anonymous.

3. Enable Two-Factor Authentication (2FA)

Enable 2FA for added security. This requires both your password and a one-time code. Go to User Settings > My Account > Enable Two-Factor Auth.

4. Review Your Privacy Settings

Adjust your privacy settings for extra security: Disable direct messages from unknown members. Block unwanted friend requests. Hide your online status if needed. Go to User Settings > Privacy & Safety.

5. Keep Personal Information Private

Avoid sharing personal details like your real name or location. This is a safe space, and it's okay to remain anonymous.

Important: If you are involved in a legal case, avoid sharing personal information that could be subpoenaed. While our server is private, it's essential to protect yourself legally.

6. Our Entire Server Is Private and Secure

Our server & channels are 100% private, and accessible only to authorized, verified members. Members who disconnect their Discord from their profile are automatically removed. This ensures only trusted members have access.

7. Report Suspicious Activity

If anything feels off or suspicious, please reach out to a moderator or admin immediately.

8. Stay Vigilant with Personal Devices

Use strong passwords, avoid public Wi-Fi, and log out when using shared devices to keep your account secure. By following these steps, you help ensure your safety and privacy. If you have any questions or need help, reach out to an admin.
